PRODUCT GUIDANCE SHEET

RELOAD No3 CONCENTRATED DAILY TOILET CLEANER



A daily use toilet and urinal cleaner/descaler which dilutes to produce a viscous liquid which clings to sanitary ware surfaces to improve cleaning action. Pleasantly fragranced to safely and effectively clean stainless steel and ceramic toilets. To aid product recognition the RELOAD No3 product label and the label on the flip-top bottle are a Blue.

HOW TO USE

Daily Toilet Cleaner Concentrate is dispensed as a controlled dose into a labelled bottle fitted with a directional cap to allow maximum economy in use over conventional ready to use toilet cleaners. Suitable for daily washroom cleaning of toilets, urinals and other sanitary ware.

Step 1: Before use, flush toilet to remove all debris and allow the water to settle. Using a toilet brush, force some of the water in the bowl around the U-bend by digging the brush up and down in the water. This will allow the product contact time with any mineral salts/scale at the water level.

Step 2: Direct the product up under the rim and allow it to run down the inside of the toilet bowl. Leave for 2-3 minutes. Complete the remainder of the surrounding area cleaning tasks. Finally, scrub the toilet bowl with a toilet brush to remove any stubborn scale or soiling and flush toilet with brush in water to remove any product left in pan or on the brush.

RELOAD No3 should be applied to toilets at the same time as you pre-spray the other surfaces to be cleaned in the toilet area. Allow suitable contact time to descale heavily soiled toilets.

Caution:

Never use this product in conjunction with a chlorine based product. It will produce chlorine gases which can be fatal if inhaled.

RELOAD No3 must be diluted before use using an Kitchenmaster bottle fill dispenser. For a bottle cleaning solution dilute with two plunges of dispenser per blue labelled Reload No3 bottle with a directional nozzle and fill with water or via an automatic chemical/water mixing station.

Bottle Fill Instructions:

- 1. Unscrew flip-top cap from bottle and fill with water to the top of the label.
- 2. Insert bottle neck on to the dispensing nozzle and push upwards priming the unit.
- 3. Position bottle on the base of the drip tray to allow vending to commence.
- 4. PULL lever towards you in an upward direction until it CLICKS. This is now ready to vend.
- 5. To vend product PUSH lever downwards. The concentrate will be dispensed into the bottle at the correct dilution to water.
- 6. Remove the bottle from the base and screw flip-top cap onto the bottle. Turn bottle upside down to ensure thorough mixing has occurred.
- 7. WAIT for the green indicator to reappear in the window before inserting the next bottle for vending.

SAFETY ADVICE

Concentrate is classified as Corrosive and Danger. Flammable liquid and vapour. Causes severe skin burns and eye damage. May be corrosive to metals. Toxic to aquatic life with long lasting effects. Do not breathe vapours or spray. Wear protective gloves, protective clothing and eye/face protection. IF SWALLOWED: Rinse mouth. Do NOT induce vomiting. IF ON SKIN (or hair): Remove/Take off immediately all contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with water/ shower. IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Immediately call a POISON CENTRE or doctor/physician.
